

LABEX WHO AM I? 2020 TRANSITION CALL

The Who Am I? Transition Program aims at financing either the end of a PhD (4th year) or a transition phase between the end of the PhD and the start of a postdoc in a different laboratory. This funding offers an opportunity to complete the thesis project and maximize publications from their thesis lab.

Eligibility criteria:

- The candidate should enter one of the two following categories: i) 4th year of PhD: be, at the time of submission, in the 3rd year of his/her PhD study or ii) Transition Post-Doc: be in the process of obtaining a PhD and have an estimated defense date in 2020.
- The host laboratory should be part of the Who Am I? consortium.
- The submitted proposals should aim at strengthening the labex scientific themes: i- Transmission of identity across generations; ii- Integrity in response to stress and challenge; iii- Plasticity and changes in identity.
Collaborative projects spanning different disciplines are encouraged.

Funding: 1 to 12 months PhD or post-doc salary

- 6) 5 major publications (recent) of the host team(s)
- 7) Who Am I? financial support to the team(s) – for each funded project, please indicate the name of the project, involved teams and the associated call.
