Call for Projects 2024

Université Paris Cité (UPCité) and Université Mohammed VI Polytechnique (UM6P) are launching a call for joint projects to implement collaboration in the fields of training and research.

1. Research Topics

This call is open to all research disciplines. The call for projects is designed to support projects in the humanities, sciences and health.

2. Duration and funding

The selected projects will be funded for 18 months from January 2025 to the end of June 2026.

A single joint project can receive up to €40,000 in total under this joint funding call, with a balanced contribution from each institution.

Funds must be spent by 30/06/2026.

3. Eligibility

- 1- Université Paris Cité: The project's teacher-researchers must be full-time faculty members at Université Paris Cité, with an employment contract for the entire duration of the proposed project. The call is also open to researchers who have a fixed-term contract at UPCité for the duration of the project. Members of UPCité Research Units are also eligible to apply for this call (e.g. CNRS, INSERM staff, etc.).
- 2- Université Mohammed VI Polytechnique: Project researchers must be full-time faculty members or postdoctoral researchers at UM6P, with an employment contract for the duration of the proposed project.
- 3- Each project must be carried out jointly by permanent teaching researchers from both institutions.

5. Application form

All applications must be sent directly to the [platform](#). UPCité applications must be endorsed by the head of your UMR or department. UM6P applications must be endorsed by the head of your department (for postdoctoral candidates only). The research plan should not exceed two pages.

The application file, as specified above, must be submitted via the [dedicated platform](#) no later than November 29, 2024 (1:00 pm local time) by one of the two project leaders from UPCité or UM6P.

6. Evaluation

Applications will be evaluated jointly by the two universities.
